TOURNAMENT RULES

1. FAILURE TO SHOW CORRECT AVERAGE WILL RESULT IN DISQUALIFICATION AND FORFEITURE OF ALL PRIZE MONEY.
To participate in this tournament each bowler must have a current USBC membership card and be a member of the Northern Utah USBC Association. Non-members living within the jurisdiction of this association who are not members of another association may enter by paying an Affiliate Membership Fee of \$16.25 BA, \$17.00 WBA (See rule 300c in the USBC Playing Rules Book.)
2. Handicap will be based on 90% of the difference between the bowler's highest established 2005-2006 Northern Utah USBC Association yearbook average and 240. If no previous 2005-2006 average, current Northern Utah USBC Association average of 12 games or more as of September 30, 2006 shall be used. All others bowl scratch. Except that bowlers with previous Northern Utah USBC Association yearbook averages may apply for re-rated average based on the previous Northern Utah USBC Association yearbook average. Responsibility for application must be made one week before the entry deadline. When previous seasons' averages are used and at the time of entry an entrant has a current Northern Utah USBC Association season average of 12 or more games which is 10 or more pins above the previous season's average, current season's average must be used. If average conditions of USBC Playing Rule 319a cannot be met, bowler must bowl scratch.
3. All USBC Certified Tournament Rules govern this tournament. All disagreements will be handled through the Tournament Committee of the Northern Utah USBC Association.
4. Team event will consist of Two Men and Two Women. Doubles event will consist of One Man and One Woman. Entrants may bowl in the Team Event or the Doubles Event more than once. No more than two bowlers on a team can place more than once in the same prize list. The same pair can place only once in the same prize list.
5. When a bowler competes more than once, their first appearance in any event will count towards their all-events score.
6. Substitutes will be allowed when necessary, but must report to the Tournament Manager (30) minutes prior to scheduled squad time.
7. When a tie occurs for the Championship, multiple Championships will be declared.
8. Unmarried grade and high school students who have not attained the age of eighteen (18) must have written consent of their parents or guardian to participate in the tournament (USBC Playing Rule 13).
9. It shall be each bowler's responsibility to verify the accuracy of their average, whether submitted by the bowler or the team captain or others. Failure to use the proper average shall disqualify score if submitted average is lower than actual average thereby resulting in a lower classification or more handicap. Prize winnings shall be based on the submitted average if it is higher than the actual average. Correction in averages can be made up to the completion of the first game. The following must be submitted if necessary: Tournament prize winnings of \$600.00 or more in any one event in the past twelve months must be submitted to tournament manager (USBC Playing Rule 319c, d and e). USBC Playing Rules Book will be used.
10. Re-rating requirements - USBC Rule 319c, d and e will be used for all participants.
11. No entry fee will be returned.
12. All prize fees will be returned 100% within each event, at a ratio of at least on prize for each five entries or major fraction thereof.
