TOURNAMENT RULES

ALL BOWLERS MUST REPORT ONE-HALF HOUR BEFORE SQUAD TIME

- FAILURE TO SHOW CORRECT AVERAGE WILL DISQUALIFY THE BOWLER AND ALL PRIZE MONEY WILL BE FORFEITED.** To participate in this tournament each bowler must have a current USBC membership card and be a member of the Northern Utah USBC Association. Women must have previously bowled a 600 or 700 series. Men must have previously bowled a 700 series. This is an actual pin fall (scratch) tournament. Only members of the Northern Utah USBC Association are eligible to enter this tournament.
- All prize fees will be returned 100% within each division, at a ratio of at least one prize for each five entries or major fraction thereof.
- Bowlers may participate in the three person team event as a member of more than one team, only under the following conditions:
 - The bowler must be a bona fide member of a league from within the Northern Utah USBC Association.
 - No more than two players can compete together more than once in the three person team event.

DRESS CODE -- NO EXCEPTIONS:

Full length trousers, slacks, levis, or denims for all bowlers. Shirts must have sleeves, no tank tops and no hats are allowed.

- There will be two divisions: 570 average and below, 571 average to 630 average. No team may participate with a combined entering average of more than 630. The average will be based on bowler's highest established 2005-06 Northern Utah USBC Association yearbook average. If no previous 2005-06 Northern Utah USBC Association yearbook average, highest current NUUSBCA average of 21 games or more as of April 04, 2007 or a verifiable USBC average shall be used. Except that bowlers with previous NUUSBCA yearbook averages may apply for re-rated average based on the previous NUUSBCA yearbook average. When previous seasons' averages are used and at the time of entry an entrant has a current Northern Utah USBC Association season average of 21 or more games which is 10 or more pins above the previous seasons' average, current seasons' average must be used.
- It shall be each bowler's responsibility to verify the accuracy of their average, whether submitted by the bowler or the team captain or others. Failure to use the proper average shall disqualify score if submitted average is lower than actual average thereby resulting in a lower classification. Correction of averages can be made up to the completion of the first game. Tournament prize winnings of \$600.00 or more in any one event in the past twelve months must be submitted to the tournament manager (USBC Rule 319-C, D and E). USBC Playing Rules Book will be used.
- Grade and high school students who have not attained the age of eighteen (18) must have written consent of their parents or guardian to participate in this tournament (USBC Rule 13).
- There will be no lofting of the bowling ball.
