## TOURNAMENT RULES

1. **ELIGIBILITY :** ANY JUNIOR BOWLER for the 2005-2006 or the 2006-2007 season can bowl in this Tournament. They may elect to receive scholarship money or a trophy. **ADULTS may** participate; however, a Trophy will be awarded to the High Handicap Series winner. No Cash!

2. **DIVISIONS:** Scratch or Handicap. Bowlers will use their final book Average for the 2005 - 2006 season or their current league average if it is greater than ten pins above last years book average. You must have your 2006 - 2007 Average Verified by your coach. If you do not have a 2005 - 2006 book average or you do not have a 2006 - 2007 average, you must use a 240 average to participate. Handicap is based on 90% of 240.

3. All disagreements will be handled through the Tournament Committee of the Northern Utah USBC Association.

4. Entrants may bowl in the Event more than once but not with the same partner. Only the highest scholarship will be issued for multiple entrants and only one Trophy per adult.

5. Substitutes will be allowed when necessary, but must report to the Tournament Manager (30) minutes prior to scheduled squad time.

6. No entry fee will be returned.

7. It shall be each bowler's responsibility to verify the accuracy of their average, whether submitted by the bowler or the team captain or on the day of the event. Failure to use the proper average shall disqualify score if submitted average is lower than actual average thereby resulting in a lower classification or more handicaps. Correction in averages can be made up to the completion of the first game.

8. **BOWLERS' AREA:** Only bowlers and tournament officials shall be permitted in the bowling area. Food and drink will be permitted only on the back counter/table areas.

9. **LANGUAGE:** The use of profanity by any bowler will **not** be tolerated. **Disqualification** will be the consequence.

10. **SCHOLARSHIPS TO BE AWARDED:** Scholarships will be award at a 1 to 8 ratio. All monies collected for Scholarships will be returned 100%. Scholarship monies will be held in the Northern Utah YABA Scholarship account where those receiving them will have until their 24<sup>th</sup> birthday to claim their Scholarships.

11. **Dress Code:** Collared shirts are mandatory for all bowlers. No hats or headgear, t-shirts or sleeveless shirts, ripped or torn clothing, low-riders or bare skin will not be allowed (i.e. pants, shorts, dresses, and the like will be worn on the hips and be at least mid-thigh in length). Extreme styles, slovenly appearance, or clothing as badges or protest, defiance, or dissent will not be permitted. No advertisements of liquor or tobacco products, any abusive language or obscene gestures. Clothing shall not be worn which advertises or depicts any substance or contraband associated with such substance that a bowler cannot legally possess or use. Night slippers, bare, or stocking feet shall not be permitted. Individual names and sponsor information on shirts are permitted and welcomed. Jeans are allowed but must be clean and in good repair. Bowlers will not be allowed to bowl until properly dressed. If in doubt, don't wear it! All disputes will be settled by a Board Director or their associate and will be final.

- Boys-slacks or jeans
- Girls-skirts, skorts, slacks or jeans.
