

2009 Golden Spike/Big Dog's Super Nine \$500.00 Bracket

How it Works.

The Super Nine bracket works like this: Entrants in the 2009 Golden Spike tournament that are competing in Team, Singles, and Doubles events are eligible to enter. We take your best first game, your best second game, and your best third game from the above events and enter the scores in the bracket with the same for each of the 64 entrants the computer will randomly assign entrants and compare handicap scores.

(This is a bowler bracket Men and Women will be mixed)

32 will advance to game 2, and 16 will advance to game 3, the best third game with handicap of the final 16 will win the bracket (cash prize of \$500.00 dollars).

A second chance bracket will be run consisting of the 15 non winners from each of the Super Nine brackets run during the tournament, the winner of the second chance bracket will receive a prize of \$50.00

Official Rules:

1. Only bowlers competing in the 2009 Golden Spike tournament, and bowling **All events** are eligible to enter.
2. Scores will be taken from the recorded results for the tournament. **If a score is reported incorrectly it is the bowlers responsibility to check the recap sheet after each game to ensure the scores are correct if a mistake is noticed please notify the bracket table ASAP to correct the score.**
Unreported errors will stand as posted and no refunds will be given.
3. A bracket will consist of no less than 55 entries, and no more than 64 entries.
4. There will be no divisions, **All Men and Women will be mixed in the same bracket.** Entry Fee is \$10.00, Payout is max 1 in 64, minimum 1 in 55, First place only \$500.00
5. Handicap percentage is the same as the Golden Spike Tournament.
6. **Results for each Super Nine bracket will be posted on the Northern Utah USBC Website. www.nuusbc.com, as completed.**
7. Refunds will only be given if 55 entries cannot be obtained, refund checks will be mailed within 30 days of the end of the tournament.
8. **Winners will be paid in cash if present, or a prize check will be mailed within 30 day's of the completion of the Golden Spike Tournament.**
9. Any disputes will be settled by the bracket manager (Ed Kopowski) the bracket manager's decision is final.
10. We reserve the right to re-rate any bowler (Re-rates will be done at the time of entry, the bowler has the right to refuse to participate and will be given an immediate refund)
