TOURNAMENT RULES

PURPOSE: This tournament determines the annual Northern Utah USBCA Youth Champions.

ELIGIBILITY: Open to all youth bowlers who are members in good standing of the NUUSBCA & bowling in an NUUSBCA certified youth league, minimum 15 games, as of February 4, 2011.

EVENTS: TEAM, SINGLES, DOUBLES & ALL EVENTS.

TEAMS: There will be three divisions: (1) 575 & over (2) 451-574 & (3) 450 & under. Four bowlers will constitute a team. Teams can be mixed, boys or girls. Three games will be bowled. The Tournament Director reserves the right to refuse team names that are hard to pronounce, lengthy or not complimentary to Junior Bowling. You may enter the team event a maximum of two times, but not more than two members can be the same on both teams. A division is constituted by five entries. Divisions may be combined.

SINGLES/DOUBLES:

You cannot enter singles without entering doubles & vice versa. In singles & doubles there will be three average divisions. A division is constituted by five entries. Divisions may be combined. An optional singles scratch division is available for an additional \$5.00.

SINGLES DIVISIONS ARE AS FOLLOWS:

BOYS: (1) 160 & over (2) 111-159 (3) 110 & under.

GIRLS: (1) 130 & over (2) 91-129 (3) 90 & under.

DOUBLES DIVISIONS ARE AS FOLLOWS:

(1) 340 & over (3) 201-349 (4) 200 & under.

All divisions will bowl three games in singles & three games in doubles. Singles will be bowled first. Each person will then move lanes to bowl doubles. Doubles may be mixed, boys or girls. Bowlers may enter singles once & doubles twice. Doubles must be bowled with a different partner.

OPTIONAL ALL EVENTS: A bowler competing in Team, Doubles & Singles will be eligible for All Events, if the fee(s) were paid in advance. The score of the first Team, Doubles & Singles events bowled will count for All Events. The Division entered in SINGLES determines the division you will enter in ALL EVENTS. You may enter both SCRATCH & HANDICAP ALL EVENTS. You can win both.

AVERAGE & HANDICAP: Handicap for all divisions will be 90% of 220. Bowlers will use their high book average for the 2010-2011 season. If no 2010-2011 book average, the bowler will use their current average, 15 games or more, as of February 4, 2012. If average as of February 4, 2012 is ten pins or higher than last year's book average then you must use that average (15 game minimum). All others will bowl scratch.

VERIFICATION: Each bowler is responsible for verifying their average on the day of the event.

Any disputes will be settled by the Tournament Committee of the Northern Utah USBCA Youth. All protests & appeals must be in accordance with USBC rule 329.

Substitutes will be allowed, if necessary, and must report to the Tournament Director 30 minutes prior to the scheduled squad time.

NO entry fee will be returned!! Returned checks (including bank fees) must be made good with cash or a bank check.

BOWLERS' AREA: Only participants & tournament officials are permitted in the bowling area. Food & drink will be permitted only on the back counter/table areas. Please, No cell phones or electronic devices in the settee area.

LANGUAGE: The use of profanity by any participant will result in Disqualification. The tournament director's decision is FINAL.

DRESS CODE: Shirts with name & city/state are encouraged. You are encouraged to wear slacks & a collared shirt. Attire must be neat, clean & proper fitting (no undergarments showing.) No attire advertising liquor, tobacco products or inappropriate language. No hats. See attachment or web site for examples of dress code. The tournament director's decision is FINAL.

SCHOLARSHIPS (teams, doubles & singles only): Scholarships will be awarded at a 1 to 5 ratio in each division. All monies collected for scholarships will be returned 100%. A minimum \$25 scholarship is guaranteed in each division. There will be the option of a trophy, not to exceed \$30 in value, in place of the scholarship.

GUARANTEED SCHOLARSHIPS (Paying only one scholarship per five entries): HIGH SCRATCH & HIGH HANDICAP SERIES (boy/girl): 1st place \$100.00, 2nd place \$75.00, 3rd place \$50.00.

SPECIAL AWARDS:

- a. **THE DEAL/THOMAS AWARD: A \$50.00 scholarship will be awarded by Becky Deal & John Thomas to one Girl with the High Handicap Game of the tournament.**
- b. **THE SARAZIN/HARRISON AWARD: A \$50.00 scholarship will be awarded by Kay Sarazin & Nicole and Gerrard Harrison to one Boy with the High Handicap Game of the tournament.**
- c. **THE LOFTHOUSE-ROWLEY/JENNER AWARD: A \$50.00 scholarship will be awarded in memory of Craig Lofthouse by Casey Lofthouse Rowley & Gene Jenner to one Boy with the High Scratch Game of the tournament.**
- d. **THE HUGHES/KOLCZAK AWARD: A \$50.00 scholarship will be awarded by Bud Hughes & Johnna Koleczak to one Girl with the High Scratch Game of the tournament.**

USBC Rules & Regulations, as published in the 2011-2012 rule book, will govern this tournament. The Tournament Director is responsible for interpretation of the tournament rules & his/her decision is final, except where an appeal is made in writing within 24 hours, if the decision involves the scoring of a game.
