## Utah State USBC Youth Tournament Rules

Rules and regulations are published in the 2008-2009 USBC rulebooks, and shall govern this tournament. The Tournament Director is responsible for the interpretation of tournament rules and the Director's decision is final, except where an appeal is made in writing within 72 hours to the State Youth Association Manager for its further consideration.

1. **PURPOSE:** This tournament is conducted annually for the purpose of determining the Utah State Champions. From each event, the best performance based on the total pin fall, plus handicap, shall be the 42nd Annual Champions.
2. **ELIGIBILITY:** All bowlers who have not yet turned 22 years of age as of August 1, 2008, and who are members in good standing of USBC within the state of Utah are eligible to participate.
3. **AVERAGE & HANDICAP:** Handicap will be 90% of the difference between the individual's average and 225.
  - A. Bowlers will use their high book average, of 21 games or more, for the 2007-2008 season (winter). If no 2007-2008 season average, then the bowler will use their high Summer 2008 book average of 12 games or more. If the bowler has neither of the above, then the bowler will use their highest current sanctioned average, for a minimum of 12 games, as of **February 16, 2009**. If average as of February 16, 2009 is (10) pins or more higher than last year's book average, then you must use the average as of February 16, 2009. All other bowlers will bowl scratch. Note: If the bowler has a winter book average, then summer book average does not count. For all Sport Bowling league averages, Rule 205 will apply.
  - B. BOWLERS MUST INCLUDE A COPY OF ALL LEAGUE AVERAGE SHEETS TO VERIFY THEIR AVERAGE don't forget to include your Travel and Gold League's and Jr./Adult League's). ALL AVERAGE SHEETS NOT ATTACHED TO THE ENTRY FORM MUST BE SUBMITTED NO LATER THAN APRIL 1, 2009 IF THE AVERAGE SHEET WAS NOT AVAILABLE AT THE TIME ENTRY WAS SUBMITTED.**
4. **EVENTS: TEAM, DOUBLES, SINGLES, AND ALL EVENTS**
  - A. **TEAMS:** There will be five (5) divisions in team. **(1) 650 & over, (2) 576-649, (3) 491-575, (4) 426-490, (5) 425 & under.** Four (4) bowlers will constitute a team. Teams can be any combination of boys and girls. Three (3) games will be bowled. Teams **MUST** have a team name. The Tournament Director reserves the right to refuse team names that are hard to pronounce, lengthy, or not complimentary to junior bowling. **BOWLERS MAY ENTER THE TEAM EVENT, NOT MORE THAN TWO TIMES, AND NOT MORE THAN TWO (2) MEMBERS CAN BE THE SAME ON ANY TEAM.**
  - B. **DOUBLES:** There will be five (5) divisions in Doubles. **DOUBLES DIVISIONS ARE AS FOLLOWS: (1) 350 & over, (2) 295-349, (3) 249-294, (4) 200-248, (5) 199 & under.** All divisions will bowl three (3) games in doubles. Doubles may be mixed, boys or girls. **BOWLERS MAY ENTER DOUBLES NOT MORE THAN TWICE, BUT DOUBLES MUST BE BOWLED WITH A DIFFERENT PARTNER.** A division is constituted by a minimum of seven (7) entries. If a division does not have seven (7) entries, they will be reclassified into another division.
  - C. **SINGLES:** There will be five (5) divisions in Singles. **SINGLES DIVISIONS ARE AS FOLLOWS: BOYS: (1) 188 & over, (2) 159-187, (3) 135-158, (4) 111-134, (5) 110 & under. GIRLS: (1) 165 & over, (2) 147-164, (3) 123-146, (4) 100-122, (5) 99 & under.** Your singles event bowled will count for awards, scholarships, and all events. All divisions will bowl three (3) games in singles. A division is constituted by a minimum of five (5) entries. If a division does not have five (5) entries, they will be reclassified into another division. **SINGLES MAY BE BOWLED ONLY ONCE**
  - D. **OPTIONAL ALL EVENTS:** A bowler competing in Team, Doubles, and Singles will be eligible for All Events. The score of the first Team, Doubles and Singles event bowled will count for All Events if the \$1.00 All Events fee has been paid. There will be a separate division for boys and girls. **THE DIVISION YOU ENTER IN SINGLES WILL BE THE DIVISION YOU WILL BE IN FOR ALL EVENTS.** Trophies will be awarded to first place only in All Events. Should a bowler place first in Scratch and Handicap, the scratch award will take precedence.

5. **ENTRY FEE:** \$18.00 per bowler, per event with an optional \$1.00 fee (to be paid only once) for those entering All Events. Money must accompany all entries for each event.

*Money Orders preferred, however, personal checks will be accepted subject to a \$15.00 service charge for any returned check. No entry fee will be refunded.*

6. **CLOSING DATE:** All entries must be postmarked on or before MIDNIGHT March 16, 2009. ABSOLUTELY NO ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED AFTER THE CLOSING DATE! It will be the BOWLER'S responsibility to make sure the entry is paid to the Tournament Director with preference given to those traveling longer distances.
7. **AWARDS:** Awards fees used to purchase trophies on a basis of one (1) for every seven (7) entries or major fraction thereof (handicap), and one (1) scratch trophy/award per division. Awards Fee's will be returned 100%. There will be an estimated \$2,400.00 in added scholarships awarded. High Handicap Game and High Handicap Series will be awarded to 1 Boy and 1 Girl in each Division (20 awards @ \$100ea. = \$2,000.00). High Scratch Series and High Scratch Game will be awarded to 4 Boys and 4 Girls above and below the median (8 awards @ \$50.00 ea. = \$400.00)}
8. **SUBSTITUTES:** All substitutions must be made at least **one hour prior to squad time**. Substitutes must have an average sheet to verify average.
9. **CHECK-IN:** All bowlers must check in **30 minutes prior to squad time and must show their current USBC membership card**. Late bowlers will not be allowed to make up missed frames. Any bowler or team arriving late shall begin play with the score count beginning with the frame then being bowled.
10. **MISCELLANEOUS:**
- A. The use of tobacco products and alcohol is prohibited in the bowling center while entrant is bowling.
  - B. Food and drinks will not be permitted in the bowling area.
  - C. Entrants shall wear proper bowling attire; a collared shirt and slacks are recommended. No hats, no shorts, no tank tops, and no low riding pants are allowed.
  - D. Only entrants and Tournament Officials will be permitted in the bowling area.
  - E. Tournament games cannot be pre-bowled, except as authorized by the Tournament Director when scores are irretrievably lost due to an automatic scoring device.
