TOURNAMENT RULES

1. **ELIGIBILITY:** Open to all junior & adult bowlers who are members of the USBC & are in good standing.
2. **DIVISIONS:** Scratch (boys & girls). Handicap (boys & girls). Handicap divisions are: 150 & above; 149 & below. (Divisions are based on the youths' average.) If there aren't enough bowlers in one division (8) they may be combined with the division above them. Bowlers will use their final book average for the 2006-2007 season or current league average, if it's 10 pins or higher over 9 games, as of Oct. 14, 2007. Average verification must accompany the entry form. If you don't have a 2006-2007 book average or current average, you must use a 220 average to participate. Handicap is based on 100% of 220.
3. **FORMAT:** The junior bowler will always start the game. The junior & adult will then take turns bowling every other ball throughout the game. If the bowler who starts the 10th frame throws a strike, they will bowl again. If they don't throw a strike, the other bowler goes.
4. **VERIFICATION:** It shall be each bowler's responsibility to verify the accuracy of their average on the day of the event. Failure to use proper average shall disqualify bowler if submitted average is lower than actual average, thereby resulting in a lower classification or more handicap. Correction to averages must be made before the end of the first game.
5. All disagreements will be handled through the Tournament Committee of the Northern Utah USBCA Youth. All protests & appeals must be in accordance with USBC rule 329.
6. Substitutes will be allowed, when necessary, but must report to the Tournament Director 30 minutes prior to the scheduled squad time.
7. **NO entry fee will be returned!!**
8. **BOWLERS' AREA:** Only bowlers & tournament officials shall be permitted in the bowling area. Food & drink will be permitted only on the back counter/table areas. Please, No cell phones or electronic devices in the bowler's area.
9. **LANGUAGE:** The use of profanity by any bowler or spectator will **not** be tolerated. **Disqualification** will be the consequence. Tournament Officials decisions are FINAL.
10. **DRESS CODE:** Shirts with name & city/state are encouraged. Youth are encouraged to wear slacks & a collared shirt. Attire must be neat, clean & proper fitting (no undergarments showing). No shorts, hats or attire advertising liquor or tobacco products or inappropriate language. Tournament Officials decisions are FINAL.
11. **SCHOLARSHIPS/AWARDS TO BE GIVEN:** Scholarships/awards will be given to the youth bowlers. Certificates will be awarded to the adults. Scholarships will be awarded at a 1 to 8 ratio or major fraction thereof. All monies collected for scholarships will be returned 100%. A minimum \$25 scholarship is guaranteed in each division. There will be the option of a trophy or plaque, not to exceed \$25 in value, in place of the scholarship.

ANYTHING NOT COVERED IN THESE RULES WILL BE GOVERNED BY THE USBC RULE/PLAY BOOK.
