TOURNAMENT RULES

<u>TEAM COMPOSITION</u>: A team will consist of one pee wee and one adult. Youth may only place once and only the top score will count for scholarship eligibility.

ELIGIBILITY: Open to all youth USBC members & adult NUUSBCA members in good standing who have registered & paid the entry fee. Youth USBC memberships must be purchased through a youth league. Adult participants, who are not USBC members may purchase a NUUSBCA Basic membership for \$10.00. If the adult is a current USBC card holder, but not a NUUSBCA member, they can qualify by paying the local association dues \$9.00

<u>DIVISIONS</u>: Divisions are as follows: Boys & Girls

SCOTCH DOUBLES FORMAT: Pee Wee throws the first shot in each frame. If they strike, the frame is complete. If the Pee Wee bowler does not strike, then the adult bowler must get up to shoot the 2nd shot to complete the frame. **The Pee Wee bowler will always shoot the first shot in each frame.**

Substitutes: will be allowed, if necessary, and must report to the Tournament Director 30 minutes prior to the scheduled squad time.

NO entry fee will be returned! Returned checks (including bank fees) must be made good with <u>cash</u> or a <u>certified check</u>.

BOWLERS' AREA: Only participants & tournament officials are permitted in the bowling area. Food & drink will be permitted only on the back counter/table areas. No cell phones or electronic devices in the settee area.

DRESS CODE –**NO EXCEPTIONS**: All participants may wear casual slacks, trousers, jeans, fingertip length shorts, skirts or skorts. Participants must wear a shirt with sleeves. Unacceptable attire includes, but not limited to: Tank tops, halter tops, bare midriffs, spaghetti strap tops, etc., sweatpants, lounge pants, jeans that are torn (skin showing), not clean or in poor condition. Attire with inappropriate questionable, or offensive language or graphics. Bowlers will be required to change if attire is deemed inappropriate by tournament management or designee. Tournament management or designee decisions will be final.

<u>CODE OF CONDUCT</u> Available at the Check-In table.

<u>SCHOLARSHIPS/AWARDS</u>: Scholarships will be given to the youth bowlers. Scholarships will be awarded based on number of entries with a minimum of 1:8. All scholarship money collected will be returned 100%. A minimum \$50 scholarship is guaranteed in each division. There will be the option of a trophy, not to exceed \$25 in value, in place of the scholarship. All scholarship/award money, including adult portion of entry, will go toward youth scholarships.

Any disputes will be settled by the Tournament Director. All protests & appeals must be in accordance with USBC rule 329. All other USBC Tournament Rules Apply.
