## TOURNAMENT RULES

TEAM COMPOSITION: A team will consist of one junior and one adult. In the event a youth bowler has no adult partner, the scores of a participating adult will be provided via random draw. Youth and/or adult bowlers may choose to participate with more than one partner for an additional fee of $\$ 16.00$. Their three-game series will be totaled with each adult name they are partnered with. Youth may only place once and only the top score will count for scholarship eligibility.

ELIGIBILITY: Open to all youth USBC members \& adult NUUSBCA members in good standing who have registered \& paid the entry fee. Youth USBC memberships must be purchased through a youth league. Adult participants, who are not USBC memebers may purchase a NUUSBCA Basic membership for $\$ 10.00$. If the adult is a current USBC card holder, but not a NUUSBCA member, they can qualify by paying the local association dues $\$ 9.00$

DIVISIONS: This is a handicap tournament. Divisions are as follows (team strength): Boys 300 \& Below, Girls 300 \& Below, Boys 301 \& Above, and Girls 301 \& Above

AVERAGES: Bowlers will use their highest Composite average from the 2022-2023 season. If a 2022-23 composite average is not available, then the highest current average with a minimum of 9 games must be used. If no average is available, a 220 average will be used to participate. Handicap is based on $90 \%$ of 220 . Summer league averages will not be considered.

VERIFICATION: It is each bowler's responsibility to verify the accuracy of their average on the day of the event. If a current average is being used verification must accompany the entry form.

Substitutes: will be allowed, if necessary, and must report to the Tournament Director 30 minutes prior to the scheduled squad time.
NO entry fee will be returned! Returned checks (including bank fees) must be made good with cash or a certified check.
BOWLERS' AREA: Only participants \& tournament officials are permitted in the bowling area. Food \& drink will be permitted only on the back counter/table areas.
DRESS CODE -NO EXCEPTIONS: The Dress Code Will Be Strictly Enforced. All participants may wear casual slacks, trousers, jeans, fingertip length shorts, skirts or skorts. Participants must wear a shirt with sleeves. Unacceptable attire includes, but not limited to: Tank tops, halter tops, bare midriffs, spaghetti strap tops, etc., sweatpants, lounge pants, jeans that are torn (skin showing), not clean or in poor condition. Attire with inappropriate questionable, or offensive language or graphics. Bowlers will be required to change if attire is deemed inappropriate by tournament management or designee. Tournament management or designee decisions will be final.

CODE OF CONDUCT Available at the Check-In table.
SCHOLARSHIPS/AWARDS: Scholarships and Awards will be given to the youth bowlers. Scholarships/Awards will be awarded based on number of entries with a minimum of 1:8. All scholarship money collected will be returned $100 \%$. A minimum $\$ 50$ scholarship is guaranteed in each division. There will be the option of a trophy, not to exceed $\$ 25$ in value, in place of the scholarship. All scholarship/award money, including adult portion of entry, will go toward youth Scholarships/Awards

Any disputes will be settled by the Tournament Director. All protests \& appeals must be in accordance with USBC rule 329. All other USBC Tournament Rules Apply.
