

## **Hall of Fame Nomination Form**

THE NUUSBCA will hold a Hall of Fame banquet every two years (even numbered years). Please complete the form below to nominate someone for the Hall of Fame. The nominee will be sent an application to complete once they are nominated. Nominations & applications will be kept on file for four years. Every two years, the candidate will be given the opportunity to update their application. A candidate may qualify for Hall of Fame recognition in **one** of the following categories:

<u>OUTSTANDING PERFORMANCE:</u> A member of the local bowling association in good standing for a total of 15 years as an adult card holder. Qualified candidates are determined using a points system.

<u>SERVICE:</u> A member of the local bowling association in good standing for a total of 15 years as an adult card holder. Qualified candidates are determined using a points system.

AMBASSADOR TO BOWLING: A member of the bowling community that contributes to the sport of bowling through league, tournament play, academic accomplishments and/or community involvement. Candidates are a positive representative for the sport of bowling. Please include an essay on why you feel they are an Ambassador to Bowling.

**LIFETIME ACHIEVEMENT AWARD:** A member of the local bowling association in good standing for a total of 15 years as an adult cardholder. To qualify in this category a person must meet **7 of the 10** following requirements:

- 1. The candidate must have held an average of 175 for 15 years
- 2. The candidate must have held a 200 average for 10 years
- 3. The candidate must have served as a league officer for 10 years
- 4. The candidate must have served as a board member for 10 years including youth board
- 5. The candidate must have participated in NUUSBCA/OBA/OWBA tournaments for 10 years
- The candidate must have a NUUSBA/OBA/OWBA tournament title
- 7. The candidate must have an honor score as defined by the USBC
- 8. The candidate must have sponsored (IE: tournaments, trophies, youth, etc) or volunteered for the NUUSBCA while not serving on the board of directors
- 9. The candidate must have placed 10th or above in a national or state tournament
- 10. The candidate must have participated in state or national tournaments for 10 years
