- Must have bowled in at least FIFTEEN (15) NUUSBCA-certified tournaments.
- Outstanding service in the promotion and betterment of the Sport of Bowling through service or outstanding leadership to the bowlers in the NUUSBCA by holding a position of line officer, director, committee chair, or other service for at least FIFTEEN (15) years.
